Since taking the oath of office on January 1, 2011, District Attorney Murray has continued to support the partnership in defensive driving with the SHCNC that began in 1989 with the previous district attorney, Honorable Peter Gilchrist. Mr. Murray's commitment to traffic safety education is reflected in the 15,000 Mecklenburg County drivers who have completed 4 and 8-hour classes at the Safety and Health Council of North Carolina since January 2011. Completing the National Safety Council Defensive Driving Course is used for drivers to earn a reduction on a moving violation or as a requirement to maintain driving eligibility.
