

# DO YOU HAVE A TICKET? IS IT FOR ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

City Code violations  
Crossing median  
Failure to reduce speed

Driving left of center  
Driving without two headlights  
Following to close

Failing to burn headlamps  
Red light violation  
Too fast for conditions

Speeding (22 mph or less over limit in all zones 40 and under) or (17 mph or less over limit in all zones over 40)

Exceeding a safe speed  
Any equipment violation  
Wrong way on a dust lane  
Motorcycle only violation  
Failing to stop for RR warning  
Failing to give turn signal

Stop sign violation  
Wrong way on one way road

**TAKE A DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE. . .**

If you have been charged with one of the offenses listed on the front, the District Attorney is willing to allow you to plead guilty to driving with improper equipment after you successfully complete our approved Defensive Driving Course. **(No Insurance Points!! No Driver’s License Points!! No Court Appearance!!) SOME EXCLUSIONS APPLY!**

**In order to take advantage of this opportunity you MUST:**

- 1) Contact Brunswick Community College. . . **DO IT TODAY!**
  - a. Classes are not offered every week AND class size is limited
- 2) Complete the one four-hour session of the Defensive Driving Program at least **THREE** working days before your court date. (If you have a Wednesday court date, you **CANNOT** take the class the Tuesday before).
- 3) Enter into a written Plea Agreement and plead guilty to driving with Improper Equipment. The plea agreement will be given to you at class.
- 4) Bring to class a money order or certified check for **\$161.00** made payable to the **Clerk of Superior Court** (Cash, personal checks, or credit cards will **not** be accepted)
- 5) Pay **\$60.00** for the cost of administering and teaching the Defensive Driving Program (Money order or certified check made payable to Brunswick Community College).

**You are not eligible and CANNOT take advantage of the program if:**

- 1) Your charge is not listed on the reverse, OR
- 2) You have participated and completed this program anywhere in North Carolina within the last three (3) years, OR
- 3) You have paid your citation before taking this course
