If you have been charged with a moving traffic violation listed on the back of this leaflet, the Safe Driving Program may be for you. This program is made available by the Rockingham County Court System and Rockingham Community College in cooperation with the Safety and Health Council of North Carolina to train motorists in the principles of defensive driving. Completion of the National Safety Council's 4-hour Defensive Driving Course may prevent assessment of insurance points on your insurance policy and points on your North Carolina driver's license.

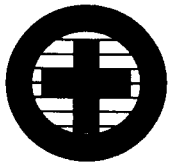
