You Are NOT ELIGIBLE For This Program If...

- ✓ You have paid off the ticket or citation before class.
- ✓ You have a CDL or your violation occurred while operating a commercial motor vehicle.
- ✓ You completed the class in exchange for a PJC, or otherwise received a PJC, in the last three years.

Definition:

A "Prayer for Judgment Continued (PJC)" means the determination of guilt by the court though no sentence has been imposed. With respect to a PJC for any moving violation, there shall be no insurance premium surcharge nor any assessment of points unless the vehicle owner, principal operator, or any licensed operator in the owner's household has a driving record consisting of a PJC for any moving violation during the three years immediately preceding the date of application or the preparation of the renewal. **GS 58-36-75(f)**

Directions To Our Office (Near Douglas International Airport)

From I-485

485 to Exit 1 South Tryon Street - Go North on South Tryon Street, 1.3 miles to Beam Road. At 3rd light, take a left on Beam Road. Three tenths of a mile come to a 4 way stop, continue on Beam Road 2 miles to Yorkmont Road. Turn right at light, go 2 tenths of a mile to Water Ridge Parkway, (First street on right). Go 2 tenths of a mile then turn right and park in the lot behind Five Lake Pointe five-story building. Enter front door of building, the Council office is on the left, ground floor.

From Interstate 85

Take Billy Graham Parkway Exit 33 toward Charlotte Douglas International Airport, continue for 3 miles then bear right onto the Farmers Market/Tyvola Road exit. Go 1/2 mile to the first traffic light, take a right on Yorkmont Road. After 2 tenths of a mile, turn left onto Water Ridge Parkway. Go 2 tenths of a mile then turn right and park in the lot behind Five Lake Pointe five-story building. Enter front door of building, the Council office is on the left, ground floor.

From Interstate 77

Take exit 5 Tyvola Road, go west toward the airport. Go 3 miles and take a left onto Yorkmont Road (at traffic light). After 2 tenths of a mile, turn left onto Water Ridge Parkway. Go 2 tenths of a mile then turn right and park in the lot behind Five Lake Pointe five-story building. Enter front door of building, the Council office is on the left, ground floor.

From Highway 74/

Independence Boulevard
Bear left onto I-277 John Belk Freeway/South. Go 2.7 miles then take Interstate 77 Exit 1B South to Columbia. Travel 4.3 miles on I-77 South then take Exit 5 Tyvola Road. Bear right, go 3 miles to 4th traffic light. Take left onto Yorkmont Road. After 2 tenths of a mile, turn left onto Water Ridge Parkway. Go 2 tenths of a mile then turn right and park in the lot behind Five Lake Pointe five-story building. Enter front door of building, the Council office is on the left, ground floor.
