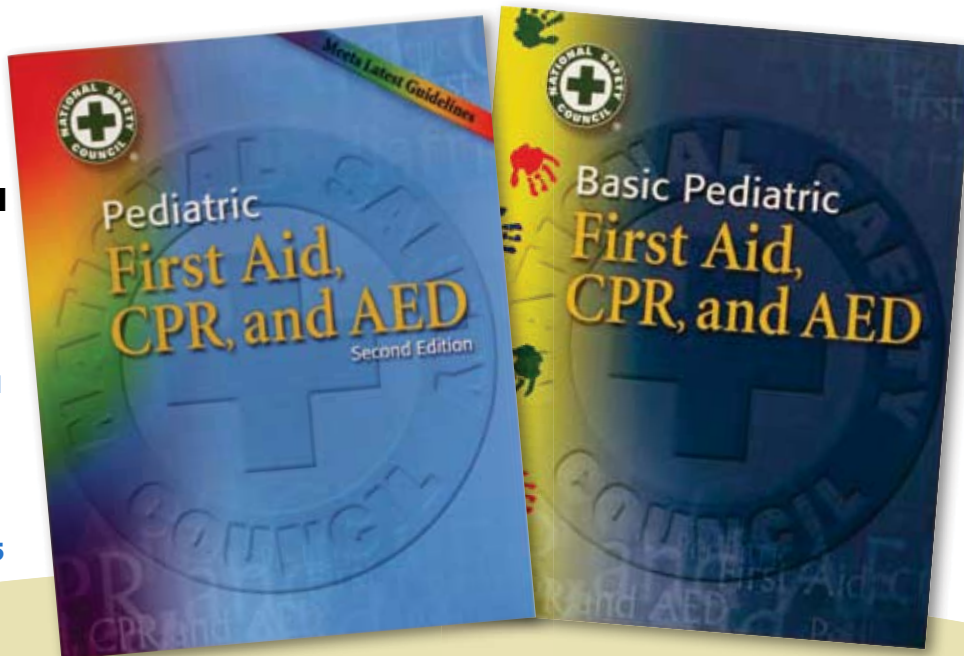

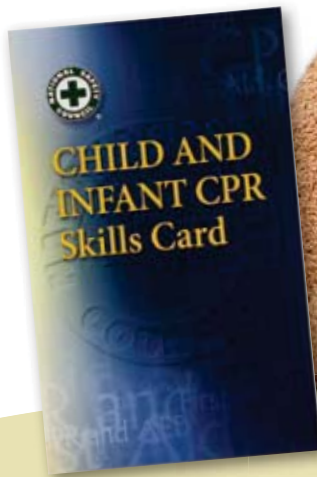
Child and Infant CPR Skills Card
